WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for Commercial Township FD No. 3 (the 'Fire District') for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 has been presented before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of November 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on November 13, 2022 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and
